Coach Mike Heny enters his third season in his return as the Head Varsity Boy's Basketball Coach at Powell High School. Last season, he led the Panthers to a 15-12 record during his second season back on the sideline. Last season's squad won the 3A West Regional championship and finished in fourth place at the state tournament. His last season with the Panthers prior to his recent return was the 2012-13 season, where Heny also led the Panthers to becoming the 3A West Regional Champions and the 3A State Runner Ups. He was named the 2011-12 3A West Coach of the Year and was the 2012 North Head Coach for the WCA All Star Game. In his 6 years as head coach at PHS, Heny has had 14 players earn All-Conference honors and 5 earn All-State. Before returning to his hometown, he spent 11 years [1995-2006] coaching at Cody Middle School where his teams had four Tournament Championships and two Runner-Up finishes. He has had the opportunity to coach 22 basketball seasons spread



out between both the middle school and high school level from Powell to Cody. In Powell, Heny has spent 6 seasons as the PHS head varsity coach, 3 seasons as the freshmen coach, and 2 seasons helping out at the 8th grade level.

Coach Jay Collins enters his fourth season as the Head Men's Basketball Coach at Northwest College. Prior to coming to Northwest College, Coach Collins spent 15 seasons coaching basketball in different programs at different levels ranging from varsity high school to the NCAA Division I level, where he spent the majority of his coaching career. Coach Collins had the opportunity to be a part of some great programs including Idaho State University, Northern Arizona University, University of Texas Rio Grande Valley, Upper Iowa University, Cochise College and Farmington High School. So far in his coaching tenure he has coached over 20 players that have signed professional contracts. Collins' passion for the game of basketball didn't start when he became a coach, but as a player. Collins won All-State Honors as a high school player, and continued his playing career at Cochise College to be named a NJCAA All-American and leading the team to its second consecutive trip to the National Tournament. He played his final two seasons at Southern Utah and was named to the All-Newcomer Team and Mid-Continent Conference. He set the school single-season assist mark (178) and ranks among the career top 10 despite playing only two seasons. He played professionally following his college career with the Idaho Stampede of the NBDL in 2003.



PURPOSE OF THE CAMP

Basketball has become more competitive than ever. In order to succeed in grade school, high school or college you must know the game.
