BRIAN ERICKSON

Coach Erickson begins his second season as Athletic Director and eleventh season as a member of the Trapper staff. In his third season as Head Coach he led the Trappers to their first Region IX Championship in 46 years. This feat was accomplished in front of the home fans as they hosted the Region IX Tournament for the first time in Northwest College history. They went on to the National Tournament, made it to the Elite 8 and finished with a 31-5 record, which is the second best in Northwest College history. In his six years at the helm he has a 120-74 record. Each team has had players that have moved on to play at D1, D2, and NAIA levels. He also got the opportunity to coach and work with the NJCAA National Player of the Year, Chris Boucher, who played at the University of Oregon and is on the Golden State Warriors G-League team.

CHASE KISTLER

Coach Kistler is going on his eleventh year at Powell High School—six seasons as head boy's basketball coach for the Panthers. Coach Kistler was an assistant for three seasons under coach Mike Heny and one season under Mark Elliot. While coaching the Panthers, coach Kistler has been the head strength and condition coach for Powell Athletics. As head coach he has helped his team reach the *WHSAA state Semifinals* game once and the *WHSAA Regional Championship* game once.

ENROLL EARLY

The Basketball Camp conforms with school regulations, regulated by the State High School Athletic Association.

PURPOSE OF THE CAMP

Basketball has become more competitive than ever. In order to succeed in grade school, high school or college you must know the game.

Our camp will give you an opportunity to learn the skills of basketball under the tutoring of the area's best coaches.

PROGRAM
