

IMMIGRATION NEWSLETTER

Health Insurance: All international students are automatically enrolled with Cultural Insurance Service International at the beginning of each semester. You will receive an email from CISI with a copy of your insurance card as well as information regarding your insurance policy. Print out your card and keep it with you at all times. You will need this card every time you visit the hospital or a doctor. For more information on CISI, you can access their website at: <http://www.culturalinsurance.com/>

Social Security: International students will only receive a social security card if they have a job on campus first. Once you are hired, Amanda or Emelee will receive an employment confirmation letter from the administration office. They will then arrange to take you to the social security office.

Driver's License: International students are allowed to obtain a driver's license in the U.S. You will need to visit the DMV office in Cody or Lovell to take a written and driving test. The cost is \$25.00. You will need to take the following documents with you: Passport, student ID, I-20, a letter from Amanda or Emelee, and two forms that prove your residency in Wyoming (cell phone bill, NWC billing statement, tax returns, etc.)

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:



CHECK YOUR PASSPORT! Your passport **MUST** be valid for at least six months at all times. If your passport is about to expire, please see Amanda or Emelee. If you get a new passport your must bring a copy to Amanda or Emelee.



CHECK YOUR I-20! Make sure your I-20 is valid at all times. Also, check your I-20 to make sure the major listed matches the major listed on your NWC Portal.



DO NOT DROP BELOW 12 CREDITS! F-1 students **MUST** be enrolled full-time. **DO NOT** drop or withdraw from any classes without talking to Amanda or Emelee first.



DO NOT WORK WITHOUT PROPER AUTHORIZATION! F-1 students are only allowed to work on campus 20 hours per week. Working off campus, without proper authorization and paperwork is illegal. If you are not sure what is and what isn't considered employment, check with either Amanda or Emelee.
